 1. The Paschal Candle will no longer be processed at the Entrance Rite.
 2. The Sprinkling Rite will take the place of the Penitential Rite. The prayers for the Blessing of the water and the Concluding Prayer are on **pp 1296-1299 of the Roman Missal published by the Catholic Publishing Corp.**; for the Roman Missal published by the Liturgical Press, it is on pp. 1453. The Gloria will be sung after the Sprinkling Rite.
 3. Incense will be used at:
 - The Entrance procession for incensing the Altar and the Paschal Candle
 - The Gospel Reading
 - The Offertory followed by incensing the Presider and the Assembly.
